Milwaukee Public Museum (MPM 29589). Verified by Gary S. Casper. Frogs were identified by mating call and mean erythrocyte length which was compared to a known H. versicolor population (Matson 1990, Herpetologica 46:457-462). A statistically significant difference existed between the mean erythrocyte length of H. chrysoscelis (19.71 um) and mean erythrocyte length of H. versicolor (25.07 um, p < 0.0001, two sample t test). Documentation for t. chrysoscelis from the eastern part of the state is needed. Specimen extends the known range of this species in eastern Wisconsin and is the first definite record for Waukesha County (Casper 1996, Geographic Distributions of the Amphibians and Reptiles of Wisconsin. Publ. Milwaukee Pub. Mus. 87 pp.).
